The Rotary Club of Marion is a civic club that meets at noon every Thursday at the Marion Community Building. We are a part of Rotary International and are one of 48 clubs in District 7670. The following information will help you understand the financial and attendance requirements that come with being a Rotary Club of Marion. We work within and for our community to improve the lives of citizens here and around the world.

QUARTERLY FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS:

Club Dues	\$10.00
District/International dues	\$54.00
RI Convention	\$ 5.00
Cost of Meals : (Choose one)	\$10.00 pay as you go \$104.00 if paid quarterly
Paul Harris Fellow Foundation	\$25.00

Therefore if you choose the "pay as you go" at the meetings your quarterly bill would be \$94.00. If you choose the meals paid quarterly, (most choose this option as only \$8.00 a meal) your quarterly bill would be \$198. When you join you can let the treasurer know which meal option you prefer. We ask that you stay with the meal you choose until the end of the Rotary year every July 1st. Changes can be made at that time.
